Dear Families,

On Monday, October 31st, the students and staff of School #4 will celebrate Halloween, as in years past, by dressing up in costumes. We will also continue with our exciting “Table and Treat” event that will allow for students to visit several Halloween-themed tables to get goodies, crafts, and other items that they will be able to take home. Please take a moment to read through our procedures and expectations for this day.

Costumes

All students are invited to wear costumes. We ask that you adhere to the following costume guidelines:

- Costumes must be appropriate for school.
- Shoes and other pieces of the costume must be safe and must fit properly.
- Limit the accessories so pieces of the costume are not lost or damaged before the end of the day. Accessories that represent weapons cannot be brought to school.
- Weapons and violent representations of any kind cannot be part of the costume.
- Makeup representing excessive blood and gore are not permitted.
- The costume, make-up, or accessories cannot interfere with the learning process of the student or of others.

We do want this event to be fun for all. We do not want any student to be afraid or uncomfortable. Please keep this in mind when planning a costume. Students who do not adhere to these guidelines may be asked to cover or change their costume.

The Event

- All classes will have the opportunity to “Table and Treat” during the day. They will be given 40 minutes for trick-or-treating and to participate in several activities planned by our PTA. Activities will include *Guess the Candy Corns* and *Pumpkin Rolling Races*. During recess, students will be able to dance and enjoy the music on our blacktop in the back with a DJ who will be providing the entertainment.
